

TIERS OF SERVICE

The three tiers are designed to provide services in support of district efforts to design effective curriculum, evidence-based instructional practices, and assessments aligned to Ohio's Standards in each content area.



TIER 1: ANALYSIS

TIER 2: CUSTOMIZED SERVICES

The team creates and implements intensive, customized professional development and assistance based on district goals and data analysis from Tier 1.
